## 2021 Giving Kitchen Cabernet Sauvignon Paso Robles

### Tasting Notes:

This Cabernet displays a deep ruby/purple hue leading to classic Cabernet notes of blackberry, black cherry, dark chocolate, and coffee beans. The mouthfeel is rich, full-bodied, and textured. The 2021 shows elegance and great length in the finish.

### Winemaking:

Hand-harvested at night to ensure cool temperatures, we cold soak the berries to draw color and develop flavors while elevating structure. Fermented in open-top stainless-steel tanks, then aged in 100% French oak barrels, 60% new, for 7 months, the wine is bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.
